

WILD PLANTS OF THE CLAREMONT CANYON WATERSHED

Kay's Master List

This list names more than 375 plant species reported growing wild in the Claremont Canyon watershed. The list is compiled from several different lists, primary among them the EBRPD list of plants in the Claremont Canyon Regional Preserve. Species names have been updated to follow The Jepson Manual: Vascular Plants of California, 2nd edition, 2012. (The name shown in the 1993 edition of the Jepson Manual is identified as JM93:..) Species whose occurrence in Claremont Canyon has been documented with a photo will soon show a link to the picture. I have chosen to present this list sorted by scientific name only. Wild plants frequently have several accepted common names, one or two of which are included below. I make no claim to have shown the most authoritative or most popular common name!
